#### 1. Academic

#### • Examination results:

The examination results of ABV GDC Sunni are although satisfactory but still there is scope of improvement in certain streams and specific subjects. In the meeting gaps and areas of improvement were identified and it was decided to have remedial classes for slow learners in the month of Nov-Dec and February.

### • Educational Trip/Exposure

Science faculty planned an educational exposure trip of first, second and third year students to CSIR-IHBT & CSKHPKV Palampur in month of October, 2024 to familiarize students with the significant role that research institutes play in diversifying their career and meeting experts and educators which offers insight and career guidance.

## • Updating Science Laboratories:

It was decided that the science laboratories will be updated by procuring instruments and chemicals to give students more hands on experiences and experience of modern technology.

# • Collaboration and MOU's

It was discussed and recommended to give practical exposure to students of commerce and science faculty by initiating MOU with some industries and higher educational institutions.

### Course outcomes

It was decided that course outcomes will be defined for each subject across the streams for upcoming session.

• The Department of English plans to conduct a Week-Long Vocabulary Building Workshop for the students of BA program who have opted for English as their major or minor subject. The workshop aims at looking at word-formation rules, etymology and contemporary usage.

## 2. Co-Curricular and Extracurricular Engagement

- The Science Club organized National Science day in which two expert speakers were invited from Jaypee University Waknaghat. The students participated in project making and quiz competition.
- Following the successful organization of the Inter College Women's Badminton Championship

- last year, the ABV Govt. College Sunni set its sights on an even larger endeavor. This year, we hosted the Inter College Men's Badminton Championship, which marked a significant expansion in scope and scale. The championship drew participation from around 51 teams, representing colleges from across the region. This impressive turnout underscored the growing interest in badminton and showcased the high level of talent among collegiate athletes.
- Recognizing the importance of recreation and community building among faculty members, the
  department of Physical Education introduced an inter-faculty cricket match this year. Unlike
  the previous year, which did not feature any recreational events for faculty, this initiative aimed
  to create an engaging and inclusive environment for both teaching and non-teaching staff. The
  cricket match included teams formed by teaching staff, non-teaching staff, and a dedicated team
  from the Department of Physical Education. The event was well-received and succeeded in
  promoting camaraderie, teamwork, and a spirit of friendly competition among faculty members.

## 3. Community Outreach and Extension Activities

- The NCC decided to host CATC camp in collaboration with Govt. Model Senior Secondary School Sunni.
- NSS and Red Ribbon Club of college decided to organize one day free medical check up camp
  in collaboration with NACO. In this camp BP, HB, TB, HIV, Hepatitis, STI, Glucose tests were
  performed and total 211 candidates including students, teachers and people from local
  community availed the facility of this camp.
- Traditionally, the NCC unit celebrated only NCC Day as a major function. This year marked a new initiative where we expanded our efforts to include the celebration of Independence Day as a significant event. This celebration was conducted in collaboration with the NCC, NSS, and Rover Rangers, bringing together multiple student groups for a unified and vibrant display of patriotism and teamwork.
- Department of Sociology and Political Science decided to conduct a social survey adopt nearby Panchayat to nurture real life experience about working of panchayats and to instill the organizational and social service skills in students.
- NSS decided to carry cleanliness and plastic free campus drive, green campus development and awareness rallies on social issues like voter awareness, anti drug, road safety and corruption.
- NSS decided to adopt a nearby village and schools to reach out to slum children in order to enroll them in adopted schools.
  - NSS decided to celebrate DAN Utsav with residents of Old-Age home Basantpur.

#### 4. Action taken on review meeting:

- Remedial Classes are planned to remove gaps in teaching learning of slow learners.
- All the labs of Science faculty have procured instruments and chemicals to update their labs and make them more equipped with required instruments and apparatus.
- The MOU with SJVNL has been signed and initially students of B.Com final year will get hands on training on the working of corporate office of SJVNL Sunni.
- The science faculty has signed MOU with Jaypee University Waknaghat to collaborate with each other by exchange of students for internships, workshops for teachers and students and sharing of research facilities.
- The educational trip was successfully organized by science faculty from 7<sup>th</sup> October to 10<sup>th</sup> October as planned in review meeting.
