







Ques 3: Did your teacher use an innovative ways to facilitate the learning process in class? How do you rate these methods?




Ques. 4: The degree of opportunity you got to exercise choice over the subject you are studying?







Feedback Analysis:

The student feedback survey from ABV Govt College, Sunni, Shimla (HP) provides insight into various aspects of academic experiences, based on a sample size of 150 students. Here's a brief analysis of the feedback:

Summary of Feedback:

1. Syllabus Enhancement (Q1):

92% of students** rated the syllabus as "Excellent" in enhancing their knowledge, indicating strong satisfaction.

2. Content Coverage (Q2):

95.3% of students rated the extent of syllabus coverage as "Excellent," showing that most students felt the prescribed content was well covered.

3. Innovative Teaching Methods (Q3):

84% of students** found the methods used by teachers to facilitate learning as "Excellent." However, **2%** rated it as "Fair," indicating potential room for improvement in teaching techniques.

4. Subject Choice Opportunity (Q4):

98% of students rated the opportunity to choose subjects as "Excellent," reflecting very high satisfaction with the academic freedom provided.

5. Curriculum's Livelihood Relevance (Q5):

89.3% of students rated the curriculum's ability to equip them for livelihood as "Excellent," but a small portion (2%) found it only "Fair," highlighting some concerns about practical applicability.

6. Availability of Course Materials (Q6):

86% of students rated the quality of books and resources as "Excellent," but 5% felt it was only "Fair," suggesting a need to improve the availability or quality of learning resources.

7. Library and Online Resources (Q7):

89.3% found the library and online resources adequate, with 6% rating it as "Good." No students rated it as "Poor," indicating an overall positive response.

8. Testing and Evaluation System (Q8):

80% of students rated the testing system as "Excellent," while 3% rated it as "Fair." This implies the evaluation process is working well for most but may need refinement for some students.

9. Practical Application of Theoretical Content (Q9):

80% of students rated the connection between theory and practical application as "Excellent," but 5% found it only "Fair," suggesting a possible gap between classroom learning and real-world application.

10. Overall Learning Experience (Q10):

80% of students rated their overall learning experience as "Excellent," with 15% rating it as "Very Good," pointing to overall satisfaction, though some students feel improvements can be made.

Actions Taken:

1. Enhancement in Teaching Methods:

Since a small percentage of students (2%) rated teaching methods as "Fair," more innovative and engaging teaching techniques (e.g., technology-based tools, interactive sessions) were introduced in the teaching learning process.

2. Improved Resource Availability:

The 5% of students rated the availability of books and resources as "Fair". More access to updated textbooks and online materials were provided and Library was made accessible 24 hours to students.

3. Practical Applications

To bridge the gap between theory and practical knowledge, more hands-on experiments and demonstrations were introduced.

4. Evaluation Methods:

Discussed the possible revision in the testing system to make it more inclusive and reflective of different learning styles, which could help the small percentage of students (3%) who are not fully satisfied.

By addressing these areas, ABV Govt College can further enhance the overall academic experience for its students.
